



DRILLING COMMENCES AT MONTEJINNI COPPER PROJECT

- A 65 hole aircore drilling program commenced on July 18.
- Testing the extents of high grade surface copper mineralisation, and soil geochemical anomalies, identified by Tempus in late 2018.
- First results expected later this Quarter.

Tempus Resources Ltd (“Tempus” or “the Company”) is pleased to advise that a 65 hole aircore drilling program has commenced at the Montejinni Copper Project, located near Top Springs, in the Northern Territory.

The maiden drilling program is testing the extent of high grade surface mineralisation, and beneath soil geochemical anomalies, targets that have been generated by Tempus through work programs in late 2018. Results from the September 2018 rock chip sampling program (previously reported), returned high grade copper, including **22.99%** (TRC010), **19.77%** (TRC001), **18.95%** (TRC003) and **12.90%** (TRC004) copper (Figures 1 and 2). Elevated silver results, up to **43.8 g/t** were also returned. Refer to ASX announcement 31 October 2018.

Soil samples collected as part of the December 2018 program were analysed using ionic Terraleach process conducted by Genalysis laboratories, for a suite of 58 elements, with the results assisting in the design of this current drilling program.

The Company will provide market updates as the drilling program progresses, with initial results expected later this Quarter.
